- All entries must be grown by the exhibitor except Decorative and Junior Sections.
- Maximum of one entry per person per class except:
 - Classes 607, 608, 611 and 615 – a maximum of 2 entries per person per class but must be different colours.
 - Classes 614, 616 and 626 – a maximum of 2 entries per person per class but must be different varieties.
 - Class 644 “Bonsai Plant” – a maximum of 2 entries per person.
 - Decorative Section 650 to 654 a maximum of 2 entries per person per class
 - Class 662 “Secondary School Aged Entrant - A single stem of flower/s” – a maximum of 2 entries per person.
- Professionals are not eligible to enter any class.
- Entry Fee: \$1 per entry for all classes except Junior classes (660 – 682) which are free.
- Exhibitors to supply their own container to present the exhibit.
- A minimum of 3 stems per container is required unless otherwise stated.
- Maximum space per entry is 30cm unless otherwise stated.
- All entry tickets must be attached to the item.
- Entry forms must be submitted online or in person by 6.30pm Tuesday 14th November 2023. For opening hours of the Show Office please refer to the website.
- Entries to be staged between 3pm – 8pm Thursday 16th November 2023 and 7am – 10.30am Friday 17th November 2023. All entries must be staged & all entrants are required to vacate the Pavilion by 10.30am Friday 17th November 2023. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.
- All exhibits must remain on display until 4pm Saturday 18th November 2023
- Exhibits must be collected between 4.15pm – 6.30pm Saturday 18th November 2023 or between 10am – 2pm Sunday 19th November 2023. Please bring your entry receipt for collection.
- Any exhibits not collected by 2pm Sunday 19th November 2023 will be thoughtfully disposed of.
